Customize Work Flow Settings

You can customize work flow settings for your users. If an employee's job is concentrated on one screen, Caretinuum® can display that screen when the user logs in. Also, you can save time for your users by specifying the criteria they use to select the data that is necessary for their jobs.

Automate Your End-of-Day Processing

You can schedule resource-intensive processes to be run automatically after business hours so that your system can run at an optimum speed when you need it the most.

Customize and Print Collection Letters

Caretinum's intuitive letter template screen helps you determine the layout of your collection letters and insert Caretinuum data fields into the letter content. After you customize the letters, it's easy to print multiple letters simultaneously.

Integrate with ZirMed for Eligibility Requests and Claims Submission

Caretinum now offers integration with ZirMed® that allows you to check a patient's eligibility with a payer and automatically transmit ECS files to dozens of payers.

Verify Physician PECOS Enrollment

Caretinum automatically indicates which of your physicians have enrolled in PECOS. This means that you'll be ready when Medicare begins enforcing the PECOS requirement – Caretinuum will prevent bills from being sent erroneously for those physicians who haven't enrolled.

Automatically Calculate Helpful Body Weight Information

When you enter the patient's height and weight, Caretinuum automatically looks up the patient's gender and uses the information to calculate lean body weight, ideal body weight, and body surface area.

Retrieve Care Plan Goals on to the 485

Caretinum gives you great flexibility when determining the goals that appear on the 485. Just double-click the block on the 485, group, sort, and filter the patient's care plan goals, and then multi-select those that you want to display on the form.

On-Screen Help for Scheduling Recert Visits

When you want to schedule a recertification visit, the last five days of the cert period are important. In Caretinuum, the patient's schedule will show you a helpful visual reminder – the last five days of the cert period will be shaded with a special indentifying color.

Monitor Time Scheduled Outside of Employees' Availability

A new Caretinuum report gives you the ability to monitor the time that has been scheduled outside of your employees' availability. For example, if an employee's availability is 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and a scheduler enters a visit for 6 p.m., the visit will display on the report. The report will show you the essential information about the appointment as well as patient contact information and the tasks that have been scheduled for the appointment.

Link Appointments and Assessments

Caretinum gives you the ability to link assessment documentation with scheduled appointments. This gives you easy access to the patient's clinical information from the schedule and the recorded visit. Clinicians can also directly link the recorded visit to the redesigned Activity Log. Now, it's even easier for clinicians to enter activities, supplies, and expenses at the Point of Care. This is the first phase of additional enhancements in this area.
